ACTIVITY

Hold hands and walk in a circle as you sing this familiar Mother Goose rhyme. When you sing “we all fall down,” gently “fall” to the ground. Then, get back up and repeat the game again! Model how to fall in a controlled way so that family members are aware of the safety of others.

The playful nature of the song is certain to produce giggles and joy for all participating. Your child loves to see you get in touch with your inner toddler and play right along with them, so make sure you share your enjoyment with them.

Young children love often repeated and predictable games. You are increasing the brain benefits of this simple song when you sing and coordinate your motor motions simultaneously.

The physical touch and positive memory of your play will also benefit all who join your “ring”!
