## ACTIVITY

Play this fun movement game with your child by standing to face them as you model different large body motions for the lyrics: **“Oliver Twist, you can't do this so what's the use in trying?”**

Give your child opportunities to practice many different moves before you ask them to contribute one. You can stomp feet, jump, kick one foot or alternate kicking feet, twist, wave your hands over your head . . . and many more! Use different levels and body parts.

Creativity does not spring from a blank page. Children need a variety of experiences and ideas to create. Give them a repertoire of motor movements over time, and then it is time to ask: what fancy move shall we do next?

Notice how the parent in the video follows her child's lead and slows down her singing to match her daughter's moves. This is a beautiful example of following a young child's lead!
